Yet biodiversity loss poses growing risks across operations, supply chains and markets. Increasingly, companies are expected not only to minimise their impacts but also to contribute to a nature-positive economy.

This workshop introduces learners to the essentials of biodiversity management through a business lens. It explores how organisations can assess and monitor biodiversity impacts, embed biodiversity into strategy, apply nature-based solutions (NbS) and report effectively under emerging global frameworks such as TNFD, GRI 304, and SBTN. Learners will leave with practical insights and tools to align biodiversity action with business resilience, stakeholder trust and long-term value creation.

Biodiversity and Business: Why Nature Matters

- The role of biodiversity in ecosystem services and business value, key sector risks and dependencies, and the business case for biodiversity action.

Biodiversity Assessment & Monitoring

- Conducting impact and dependency assessments across operations and value chains using tools such as TNFD LEAP, biodiversity indicators, and practical monitoring frameworks.

Strategy & Integration: Embedding Biodiversity into Business

- Setting biodiversity goals and KPIs, applying the mitigation hierarchy (avoid, minimise, restore, offset), and building partnerships with NGOs, communities, and regulators.

Exploring Nature-Based Solutions

- Understanding NBS, business applications such as mangrove restoration, watershed protection, and agroforestry, and financing approaches including biodiversity credits and ESG funds.

Reporting on Nature

- Using key reporting frameworks such as GRI 304, TNFD, SBTN, & ISSB/IFRS, with indicators to measure biodiversity performance and communicate outcomes to stakeholders & investors.

Future Outlook: Towards a Nature-Positive Economy

- Global biodiversity frameworks, emerging nature-positive strategies in business and finance, evolving regulatory expectations, and new biodiversity finance mechanisms.
